



Mirosław Matyja is a political scientist, economist and historian. He is an alumnus of Kraków University of Economics and University of Basel. He received PhD in economics in 1998 from University of Fribourg (Switzerland), in humanities in 2012 from the Polish University Abroad PUNO in London, and in social sciences in 2016 from Maria Curie-Skłodowska University in Lublin.

Mirosław Matyja is a professor at the Polish University Abroad in London and chairs its Institute of Political Culture and Democracy Research. He has authored or co-authored 14 monographs and over 200 scientific and popular articles in Polish, German, and English.

He is the author of *Szwajcarska demokracja szansą dla Polski* (2018) and *Polska semidemokracja. Dylematy oddolnej demokracji w III RP* (2019). He lives in Switzerland with his wife and two twin sons.

Today's modern representative democracy, based on the rule of people's vote, is facing various challenges leading to conclusion about a crisis of the state. In various countries, citizens and politicians are looking for new solutions for operating of the political and decision-making system. Switzerland is a rare example of the country with tools regarding direct democracy: referendum, popular initiative, popular veto. Swiss citizens are very sovereign and have more political power than people living in a representative democracies.
